## Section 11: TEMPORARY BUSINESSES

**11.1 Definition**: A **temporary business** shall mean the sale of goods or services sold by a business being operated in the city for less than forty-eight (48) hours or operating out of a vehicle, truck, trailer, or other mobile unit.

## **11.2 Application for Permit**

An application for a permit to run a temporary business under this ordinance shall be made at the City Office. Such application shall be sworn to or filed with the City at least four weeks prior to the time in which the permit applied for shall become effective. The application shall contain the following information:

(1) The name, address, or headquarters of the person applying for the permit;

(2) If the applicant is not an individual, the names and addresses of the applicant's principal officers and managers;

(3) The name and address of the person or persons who will be in direct charge of conducting the temporary business;

(4)The time within which the temporary business will be operated and the location of the temporary business in the City;

(5) Any application for a temporary permit must also be signed by the party on whose property the temporary business shall be located.

## **11.3 Investigation**

The City Clerk or designee shall examine or cause to be examined each application filed under this ordinance for a permit and shall make or cause to be made such further investigations of the applicant as is deemed necessary. The permit will be issued when the City Clerk or designee determines the following facts:

(1) That all the statements made in the application are true;

(2) That the applicant has not engaged in any fraudulent transactions or enterprise;

(3) That nothing in this proposal will violate any provision of the zoning ordinance of the city;

(4) That the application has been approved by the City Council of Bear River City.

## **11.4 Permit Fees**

(1) Before a permit is issued, the applicant shall pay to the City the appropriate fee, which shall be set in the Bear River City Fee Schedule. The temporary license shall allow a temporary business to operate for forty-eight (48) hours or less within the City.

(2) An applicant for a temporary business may secure a permit, which will allow him or her to operate the temporary business off and on through one calendar year. The fee for the year-long temporary permit shall be set in the Bear River City Fee Schedule.
