

Bear River City Ordinance No. 2026-05-04

RV Waste Dumping Station Ordinance

Section 1. Purpose and Intent

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish and regulate the use of a municipal recreational vehicle (RV) waste dumping station for the benefit of Bear River City residents, to protect public health and safety, and to prohibit vandalism, improper dumping, and damage to City property.

Section 2. Establishment and Location of RV Dumping Station

A. Bear River City hereby establishes an RV waste dumping station ("RV Dumping Station") located on the west side of the Bear River City Park, at a location designated and maintained by the City.

B. The RV Dumping Station is provided as a convenience for Bear River City residents only, unless otherwise authorized by the City.

Section 3. Authorized Use

A. Use of the RV Dumping Station is limited to:

Bear River City residents; and

Waste generated from personal recreational vehicles (RVs), campers, or trailers owned or used by such residents.

B. Proof of residency may be required upon request by City staff.

Section 4. Prohibited Acts

The following acts are strictly prohibited at or near the RV Dumping Station:

A. Dumping or attempting to dump:

Portable toilets or porta-potties;

Commercial waste or waste generated outside Bear River City;

Solid waste, trash, grease, chemicals, or hazardous materials.

B. Damaging, vandalizing, defacing, tampering with, or misusing:

RV Dumping Station equipment;

Plumbing connections, valves, lids, or surrounding infrastructure;

City signage, cameras, fencing, pavement, or park facilities.

C. Using the RV Dumping Station in a manner inconsistent with posted instructions or City policy.

D. Allowing waste to spill, leak, or discharge onto the ground, roadway, park area, or stormwater system.

Section 5. Maintenance and Cleanliness

A. Users shall leave the RV Dumping Station in a clean and sanitary condition.

B. Any person responsible for a spill or discharge shall immediately notify the City and may be held responsible for all cleanup and remediation costs.

Section 6. Enforcement Authority

This ordinance may be enforced by:

Bear River City staff

Section 7. Penalties

A. Any person who violates this ordinance is subject to the following penalty:

\$1000 fine and shall be liable for the remaining full cost of repair or replacement.

B. Any person who causes damage to City property shall be liable for the full cost of repair or replacement, in addition to any fines imposed.

Section 8. Severability

If any provision of this ordinance is found to be invalid or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.

Section 9. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and posting as required by law.
